




****Caras Conocidas****



Notable Hispanics Intermediate-Advanced Culture Lesson



~ Here are teacher suggestions for teaching this Notable Famous Hispanics lesson. There are many ways to approach this lesson though, so choose the one that suits your students the best.

~ The first day, have the students watch this four minute video with 25 notable Spanish speakers. Tell the students that they need to try to remember as many names and faces as possible.

*Distribute the packets with the descriptions of the famous Spanish speakers among the students so they can read them in front of the class and so they can follow along while other students are reading. The teacher may choose to hand out the information packet a few days in advance so students can read the information in advance.

the student practice reading the descriptions of their famous people (which they received) and the ones they will present so they can practice in case there are words they may need to pronounce correctly).

*After the students have practiced for a few minutes, have the student who has the Frida Kahlo picture come up in front of the class to read the description. While the student is reading, the teacher can show the famous person's picture on the screen and he/she can play the following video with Kahlo's famous works of art.

*Finally, use the discussion questions and the quiz as a means of assessing student learning or to spark a lively class discussion about these notable Spanish speakers.

***Another way to teach this unit is to show the video at the beginning of the Famous Spanish-speakers lessons (Caras Conocidos) then teach a few notable Latinos each day until they are all learned about all 25 of them and then show the video at the end of the unit.
