Brain Research Shows:

We remember: 10% of what we hear. 15% of what we see. 20% of what we both see and hear. 40% of what we discuss. 80% of what we experience directly or practice doing. 90% of what we attempt to teach others. - Edgar Dale

*Remind students that if you tell them the answer, they will remember 10% (and you will remember 90%), but if you make them look it up, their retention potential jumps to 80%,
